

INTERNSHIP: FORUM+ IS LOOKING FOR AN EDITORIAL ASSISTANT (f/m/x)

FORUM+ is the peer reviewed journal for research and arts in Belgium and the Netherlands. The journal explores the latest trends in research in the arts, which is gaining importance in higher arts education in Flanders and the Netherlands. FORUM+ stimulates the dialogue between research in the arts, critical reflection and the social context in which it is established: this way, the journal offers a platform for creative approaches and critical reflections on our world. The arts are deliberately defined in the broadest sense: a.o. music, drama, dance, (audio-)visual arts, ... The interdisciplinary profile of FORUM+ offers room for discipline-related topics, but also allows for the exposure of cross-links and differences. The name reflects this intention: the journal wants to be a forum for the exchange of ideas, with a plus.

You will gain experience in the coordination and workflow of a journal. We offer you professional guidance in writing a review or other contribution of your choice. You work as a freelancer and plan your own hours. The internship is unpaid. Editorial meetings take place in Antwerp or online.
